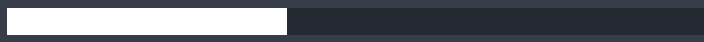

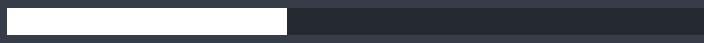

Projects

Vending Machine Spring MVC Application :

- Utilized a combination of HTML, CSS, JSP's, JSTL, Spring MVC, and Java to create a virtual vending machine web application.
- Created buttons dynamically by connecting JSP's to the Controllers, wired through the Service Layer and fetched data from the in-memory DAO.
- Kept track of each item quantity and change inserted by the user to display custom error messages when an item runs out or a user has insufficient funds.

Flooring Business Application :

- Implemented Java and the Spring MVC Framework to create a business application for a flooring company that enabled users to add, delete, and edit clients and orders.
- The program was also capable of reading from and writing to files to allow for product and state tax updates.

Superhero Sightings Application :

- Employed Java, Spring Frameworks and MySQL to create a program that allows users to report sightings around the world of their favorite superheroes.
- Implemented Spring Security to differentiate between a regular user and an administrator using a login page and password hashing.
- Used REST and Web API to create a user interface with interactive buttons using HTML, CSS, Bootstrap, Javascript, and jQuery.
- Linked a database to the application using MySQL to keep track of sightings and information on user.
